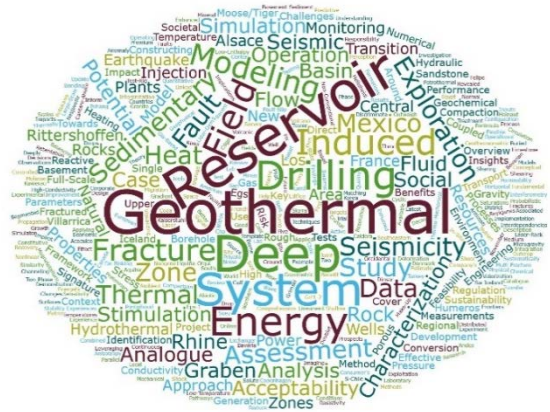
7th European Geothermal Workshop
